

Joad's Crossing. HO – Transition point from third rail to overhead on a Sacramento Northern branch in the late 1930s.



Beagle Avenue. HO - An interurban freight terminal on the Lake Shore Electric/Lima Route in the 1930's.



Little Third Rail. HO - A whistle stop on the Chicago, Aurora and Elgin (aka The Great Third Rail) during the 1920s and 1930s.



Sand Pebbles Street HO dual gauge - Patterned after San Pedro Street in Los Angeles between 1935 and 1945.



SIRT South Beach Branch O 2 Rail – Two stations Belair Road and Wentworth Avenue.



NYCTA 42St. Shuttle O Hi Rail – Track 4 at Grand Central 1970s to present.



SIRT Staten Island Transfer HO – Transfer point between SIRT and NYCTA in the 1960s and 70s.



Lake Shore Electric Roxie's Branch (aka Burke Layout) O 2 Rail – Restored antique layout built by master modeler John Burke.
