DIRECTIONS:

Driving from the East:

From Route 80 west, take exit 47 (Route 46West/Parsippany) and merge directly onto Rt. 46 West. Stay in right lane for 1.6 miles. Just before 3rd traffic light, make the jug handle left turn, Crossover Rt. 46. The Parsippany PAL is on the left side.

Driving from the West

From Route 80 east, take exit 45, (Lake Hiawatha) and make a left onto South Beverwyck Road. Continue to Route 46 and at the Troy Hills Shopping Center turn left onto Route 46 West. Stay to the extreme right and make the jug handle left turn. Crossover Rt. 46. The Parsippany PAL is on the left side.

Mass Transit:

Hourly bus service via Lakeland Bus lines from the Port Authority Bus Terminal to the Baldwin Ave. stop is available. See their web site for current schedules (www.lakelandbus.com)
